



# Instinctive Target Interception Shotgun Shooting School

Dear Shooter:

Classes could be conducted in your area if you would have four or five students for three days, normally I require five students per day (6 is max for a class) for two, three or more days. I would only supply instruction. The classes could be conducted at one or two clubs in your area. The students would have to pay for the birds and their own ammunition. I charge \$250 per day per shooter with a minimum of four or five shooters per day, which would amount to \$500.00 to \$750.00 per shooter. It could be arranged that some students would take a two-day course and others would take a one-day course, but I would need four or five people for two to three day's minimum. I look forward to hearing from you. Call I.T.I. and find out if a three-day course or four-day course would be best suited for you.

**Small Groups:** Students can also come out to Idaho Falls, ID for one, two, three or four days and train. You can do a series of half-day lessons or full day lessons. The rate is \$250.00 per person for a full day or \$150.00 per person a half day for three or more people, plus a cost for birds. You can supply your own shells or I can supply them at an additional charge.

**Private/Semi Private:** If you are by yourself, or a couple, I recommend only half-day lessons because you'll shoot 250 to 500 rounds in a half day. The rate for a half-day private or semi private lesson is \$200.00 per person; a full day is \$400.00, plus the cost of birds. If a trapper is necessary the cost is \$25.00 per half day. There are three places to train in the area. There is skeet, trap and sporting clay facility just twenty minutes away and another area with skeet, sporting clays and a five stand along with bird hunting also twenty minutes away. I also have manual and automatic traps, which we can set up in different areas. I will also be teaching in Jackson Hole, WY and Sun Valley, ID, Montrose/Telluride, CO and Albuquerque, NM

The first day of the course will be spent seeing what your current abilities allow you to do in various shooting situations and to find your problem areas. You'll be given pointers on how to correct things that are giving you problems. Subjects covered will include balance, posture, foot placement, proper holding of the gun, proper pointing of the gun, angle of gun in relation to the flight path of targets, eye focus area, proper use of the eyes, shooting glasses and colors, mind set, hold point for gun, gun mount and swing, reaction time, interception of the target, sight picture or relationship of the target to the barrel, and follow through. Proper shells and shot sizes for given applications, advantages of different type shotguns, and fitting of a shotgun.

The second day will be spent developing and honing your skills to effectively smash targets consistently at different distances and angles. You'll be shooting targets quicker and more successfully. Your bad shooting habits should have disappeared, and you'll be utilizing new shooting techniques to hit your targets.

Days three, four and five will be spent shooting more difficult targets on sporting clays courses and learning the different leads necessary to take the variety of targets thrown. You'll be shooting rabbit's, mini's, midi's, batteau's, rockets and standard targets, depending on what the facility has available at the time. If you have any questions, please advise.
